



The Argonauts' Treasure Hunt

An event designed for up to 8 teams of 4 to 8 people in "ferocious" (!) competition throughout the day, based upon land and water activities at Friday Island.

The Treasure Hunt is a great way to have fun in teams.

Each team, armed with a map and initial set of clues, needs to visit up to 10 locations in a well ordered circuit.....possibly! At each location they will have to complete a logical fun task, challenge or activity in order to gain further clues. Either way, successfully visiting locations and completing tasks will gain them a question, which they have to answer. These answers combined together will provide them with a final clue to the treasure location and several bottles of champagne. Each team has an instructor. The instructors' ruling is final.... They are unbribeable! Suitable watercraft will be available with which to go forth, complete the tasks and recover the clues and treasure as necessary.

The tasks and challenges (scattered around the islands) might (!) include some of these:



Itinerary: (Timings are flexible)

- 10.30 am Guests arrive at our Spine Road Car Park where they are ferried over to Friday Island by boat.
- Coffee and biscuits are served. Guests are introduced to the instructors, split into teams and briefed on the day's events.
- 11.00 am The Treasure Hunt begins.
- 1.00 pm-ish Teams re-group on Friday Island - no conferring!
Lunch will be served in the marquee.
(Compulsory 45 minutes stop).
- 2.00 pm Activities resume.
- 4.30 pm Guests regroup on Friday Island for tea and cakes.
onwards The steaming Hot Tub and Champagne treatment awaits the winning team !
- 6.00 pm approx Guests are ferried back to the Spine Road car park and depart.

Please advise guests participating in land and/or water based activities to bring a towel, a change of clothing/footwear and suitable wet weather gear.

The option exists to run the event on into the evening. An enjoyable way to unwind whilst being entertained by a steel band and limbo dancers. A bonfire is lit on the water's edge and of course a full Caribbean bar is open in the thatched pavillion.
